

Across the Atlantic, Pool B action in Houston's Daikin Park saw Team USA—dubbed the "Dream Team"—showcase their offensive depth. Aaron Judge, serving as captain, set the tone with a home run in his very first at-bat of the tournament,

leading the U.S. to a **15-5 rout** of Brazil.

Meanwhile, in Miami's loanDepot Park (Pool D), the Dominican Republic reminded the world of their "powerhouse" status. Behind the bats of superstars like Julio Rodríguez, the Dominicans outslugged Nicaragua to secure their first win.

The tournament is moving at a lightning pace. Pool play will wrap up by March 11, with the top two teams from each group advancing to the Quarterfinals. For the first time, Houston and Miami will share hosting duties for the knockout rounds starting March 13, before the world converges on Miami for the **Championship Game on March 17**.

Beyond the trophy, this tournament serves as a crucial qualifier for the **2028 Los Angeles Olympics**, with the top two teams from the Americas (alongside the U.S.) securing their spots early.
